Top designers introduce dynamic flooring products to the market.

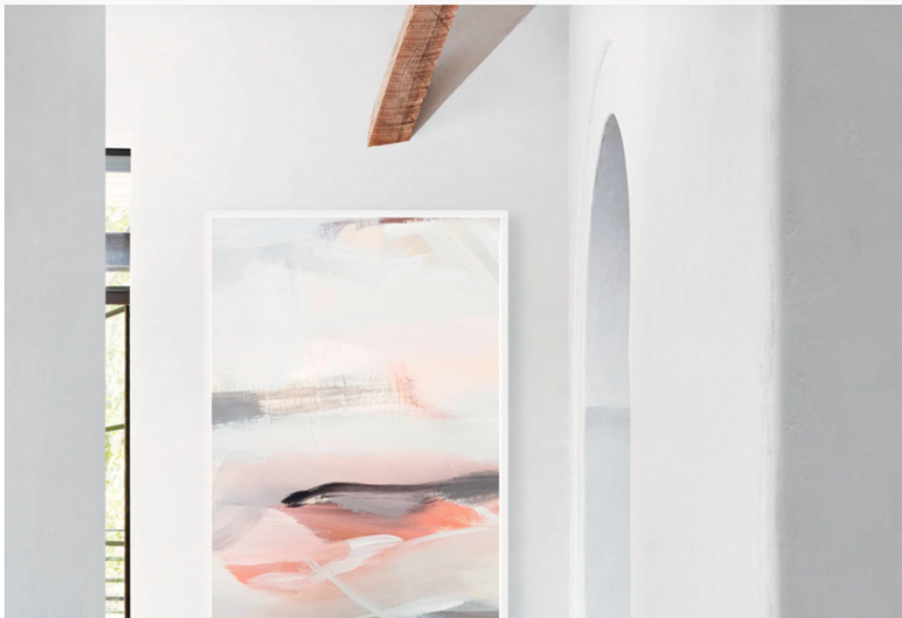

Standout: The industrial and interior designer whose star is rising crafted a worsted merino wool rug with an Asian-inspired sun shape offset by a traditional vine design.

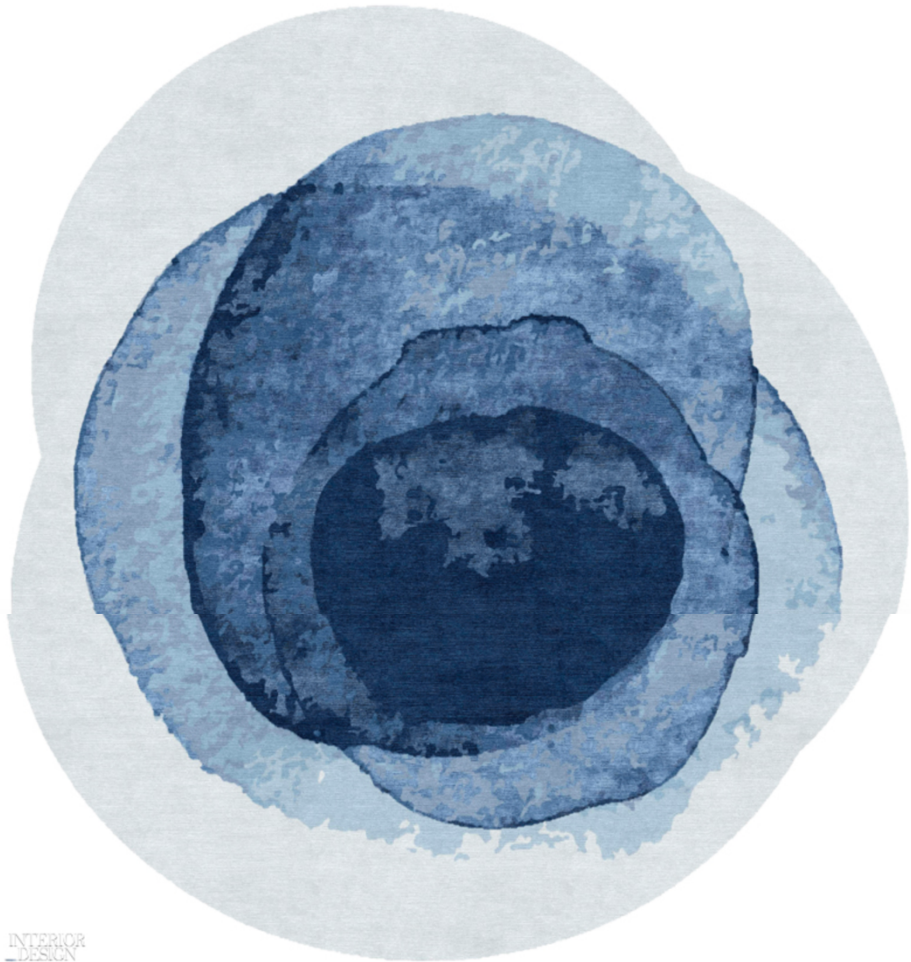
